Easter

The children have been involved in lots of Easter activities this month. As expected the Easter Bunny paid a visit to Nursery leaving lots of treats for everyone. The children were all very 'egg-cited' to take part in our annual Easter Egg Hunt. The Squirrels made bunny bags, which they used to collect their eggs in as they searched. They counted out how many eggs they each found to see who had collected the most. The Caterpillars searched in the Easter sensory pool, looking underneath shredded paper and feeling with their hands. The Butterflies decorated hard boiled eggs, using different techniques to create their designs.









Each room made their own individual Easter nests. They melted the chocolate and added broken up shredded wheat, cornflakes or rice Krispies. They mixed them together to create their nests. Each room used a different types of confectionary to create their 'eggs' on their nests.
