# **Bonfire Night and Fireworks**

All the children had lots of fun creating Bonfire and Firework arts. The Squirrels made delicious Bonfire treats, dipping apples into chocolate and sprinkles. They also used a lots of different creative ideas to make bonfire pictures, getting to choose which design they wanted to make. There were; chalk fireworks on black card, cardboard tubes dipped in paint, cupcake cases and forks dipped in paint. The Butterflies made some tasty treats too, by dipping breadsticks into chocolate and sprinkles to create edible sparklers. They were also very creative, painting their hands bright colours to make campfire art. In the Caterpillar room, the children explored a firework sensory tray and mixed food colouring into foam. They also used kitchen roll tubes to make explosive firework art by dipping the tubes into paint, pressing and spinning them around on the paper to make multicoloured bursts.





The Squirrels took on the role of firefighters, putting out 'fires'! They learnt about what they needed to wear, who to call if there was a fire and how to be super safe.
